TOBA TO HOLD BREEDING CLINIC IN LEXINGTON, KY.

LEXINGTON, Ky. -- The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association (TOBA) announced today that it will hold a Thoroughbred Breeding Clinic Friday, May 29 – Sunday, May 31 in Lexington, Ky. The clinic, sponsored by Blood-Horse Publications, will offer topics including planning a mating, conformation, foal registration, equine nutrition, pasture management, foaling and farm management. The clinic features visits to Taylor Made Farm, Three Chimneys Farm and Denali Stud.

The clinic will begin at 8 a.m. on Friday, at the Hyatt in downtown Lexington. The registration fee for the clinic is \$450 for TOBA members and \$550 for non-members and includes all support materials, breakfast and lunch.
