TOBA TO HOLD NEW OWNER SEMINAR DURING SARATOGA MEET

LEXINGTON, Ky. -- The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association announced today that it will conduct a New Owner Seminar on Friday, August 10, at the Beresford Gallery in Saratoga Springs, N.Y. The seminar, sponsored by Blood-Horse Publications, will feature discussions on industry business issues, options for acquiring horses including partnerships, auctions and claiming as well as a discussion about veterinary topics. Speakers include Don Little of Centennial Farms, Jack Wolf of Starlight Stables and trainer Kiaran McLaughlin.

The seminar will begin at 8 a.m. and will include lunch and an afternoon of racing at Saratoga.
